Splash Park = Fun
Located right next to Cohanitzk Zoo, this 7,500 square foot venue contains 28 fixtures featuring everything from buckets and fountains to water wheels and cannons, all designed to shoot, spray, mist, and pour water on bathers looking to beat the heat on summer days. Aside from the actual spray deck itself, which covers 2,334 square feet, the venue also features a washroom facility, concession stand, outdoor shower, 2 pavilions, benches, lighting, and sitting areas where bathers can relax and parents can sit in the shade and keep an eye on smaller children. Gohanitzk Zoo
The Cohanitzk Zoo is home to nearly 100 animals representing more than 45 different species from around the world, the zoo is a regional destination for families. It is a small free zoo, nestled in a wooded area along the banks of the Cohansey River, situated on approximately 15 acres within the City of Bridgeton's beautiful 1,100 acre park.
